

A Jewish woman in my group said it was a hard scene to read. Kudos to Hannah for keeping us guessing up to the end! Learning the truth about Julian made us ask the obvious question, Did Antoine know? The reader, Polly Stone, does a fabulous job with adding a French flare to just the right places. Do you think that at end of experiencing such horrors it is more of a burden to die or to live? In war we find who we are." How do you think that this is ultimately true for Isabelle and Gaëton's relationship? Boiling will cause the honey to crystallize and thicken. But she could also see how wrong it was to take him away from a woman who loved and raised him. My book club met last week to talk about a book I really enjoyed, *The Nightingale* by Kristin Hannah. I wasn't the only one who'd enjoyed this book via audio and the others who had agreed with me that the narrator was great and she kept us engaged the whole time. Did you feel that this was the best decision for Ari? He seemed rather well-developed for a character that disappeared. How did you feel that the choice of narrator greatly impacted this novel and your take away? Hannah has said that this was her favorite scene to write. It seemed like a very European dish and the culinary lavender, reminiscent of French lavender fields, really made me feel as if I could be there in the Pyrenees or in Carrievau with Vianne and Isabelle. *The Nightingale* Book Club Questions and Recipe French Bread with Goat Cheese and Lavender Honey Madame Babineau set out a meal of bread and sweet lavender honey and creamy goat cheese. The copy of the book we had contained an interview with Hannah. In fact, it was the book that stirred the passion in my heart again for reading and story telling. Why or why not? Some others felt the same but others thought that it was an accurate depiction of a relationship grown out of a time at war. They realized that meant he was printing material and reasoned that it was for the resistance. However, being reunited with Gaëton so short a time makes us question what more she would have wanted. A few women in my group said they figured out that he was part of the resistance before he revealed that fact to Isabelle. Until next time, write on. A meal of hope and possibility amongst the darkness and cruelty. One of the men was from Oregon, where we know one of the sisters ends up living. At the end, which sister did you most empathize with? Because of its impact on the world there are many novels about WWII. She talked about how she was inspired by the story of a Danish woman who created an escape route for downed airmen, much like Isabelle. It was a great discussion and I was so glad to talk more about this incredible book with fellow readers. Beck's death was a very conflicting time. And, after reading it, I thought THIS is exactly what a good story should be for a reader. *The Nightingale* by Kristin Hannah *The Nightingale* is an all-encompassing experience that wears you out by taking you through the full range of emotions and leaves you contemplating life. He's rejoicing in the fact that they're all alive. He's choosing not to admit or say aloud that Julian isn't his. Either way, this book will leave you thinking. What was your favorite part of the book? Where does this novel rank amongst them for you? We were sad when he died, even if he was a German. She mentions that in one iteration of the novel, Isabelle fell in love with a downed airman. Were you familiar with the events of the novel? However, this book is somewhat unique in the choice of narrator. Why? Vianne fought the war at home, living with a Nazi under her roof, and was still able to save several Jewish children. However, when she is forced to choose between Captain Beck and Isabelle, the choice is easy. With her husband gone to the front, she has little choice but to succumb to the will of the Nazis in order to protect herself and her young daughter. Vianne's sister, Isabelle, has other plans, though. It almost felt like a betrayal to cook something warm and wonderful after reading about such horrific hunger during the Nazi occupation of France. However, when Isabelle embarks on her first mission over the Pyrenees, Madame Babineau serves her and the downed airmen a meal of French bread, goat cheese, and lavender honey. How did you feel about the choice to keep the narrator of the opening chapter secret until the end of the book? Did the subject of the Nazi occupation of France during the war open a new facet of WWII history for you? If you use a harder cheese, it may not taste as heavenly! *The Nightingale* Book Club Questions: *WARNING: May contain spoilers! There are a lot of WWII novels. She doesn't have a personal connection to WWII but this story inspired her to do research about it. This mission was such a turning point in the book towards hope, that I thought it was an appropriate recipe. And, a book with a steady plot full of twists and turns. I was actually able to listen to it on audiobook, which was fantastic. What would you have done? Who did you think was braver—Vianne or Isabelle? How do you think that the tragedies of war made this choice clearer for the characters? In the end, only one sister lives. It was obvious that Beck had a moral compass and knew what was happening was wrong. He was stuck doing something he didn't want to under the guise of serving his country. He was a prisoner, much like Vianne. I wonder if it was the first airman she helped. Torrance. He was in and out of the book so often that I felt you didn't get attached to him. It sets a tone early on that the narrator has done something she feels she needs to be forgiven for. Or allow to cool. Slice the French bread into thick slices. As Antoine says about the baby, "We choose to see miracles." In what way do you think that the beginning of forgiveness is in choosing to see miracles? Were you able to relate more closely to the characters because Kristin Hannah uses the effects of the occupation on characters' homes and daily life as a backdrop for the novel? Vianne and Captain Beck share a friendship that is borderline romantic. The book forced you to ask yourself if you would put yourself in harm's way to save someone. For *The Nightingale* recipe: It was very hard for me to pick a recipe for a book so inundated with starvation. Mainly, it was due to the line on page 384 where the woman says, "Juliette hasn't existed for a long time." I thought she was talking about her persona, Juliette, not her sister, Isabelle. Did one take more courage than the other? The first line of the book is, "If I have learned anything in this long life of mine, it is this: in love we find out who we want to be; in war we find out who we are." The narrator is making a point that love is ideal and we can be our ideal selves, while war is the reality and the bad side of humanity.
